

SLED looking at Tigers track coach

'Breach of trust' being investigated regarding Pollock

Bob Pollock, Clemson University men's track coach for 19 years, is under investigation by the State Law Enforcement Division over a "breach of trust."

"At the request of the Clemson University police department on May 7, we were asked to investigate a charge of breach of trust regarding a Clemson employee," said SLED spokesperson Bobbi Schlatterer.

Bob Arial, 13th Circuit Solicitor, said he was aware of the in-

vestigation.

"My office has received a report of a SLED investigation of alleged misconduct on behalf of the men's track and field coach at Clemson University," Arial said in a statement.

Arial would not confirm the coach's name.

Clemson athletic director Terry Don Phillips confirmed through a school spokesman that Pollock is subject of a SLED investigation.

"We are aware of the SLED investigation," he said in a statement. "We won't have any comment on the investigation at this time."

Pollock could not be reached.

Asked when the investigation might be completed, Schlatterer said, "We don't put any parameters on any investigation."
